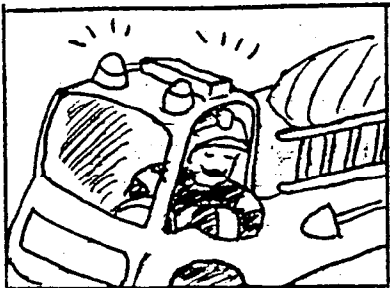

A Walk through The Theme Park Built Just For Kids

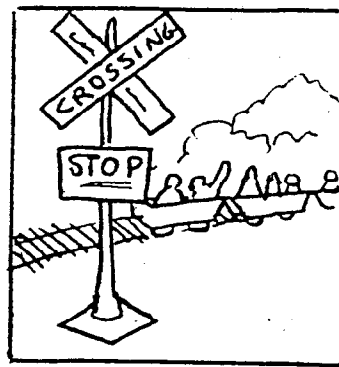


911 RIDE
