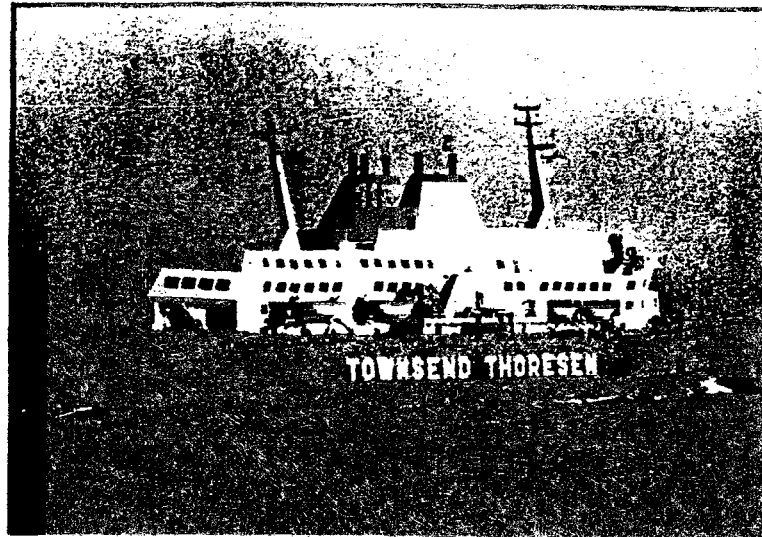

HOW SAFE ARE FERRIES ?

A report published in July came to some alarming conclusions. It said that 70% of the ferries using British ports could be dangerous.

Last year, a ferry sank in the Baltic Sea. Several years ago, another ferry, (the Herald of Free Enterprise) sank in the Channel. Both times, lots of people were drowned.

Car ferries are the opposite of icebergs. Nine tenths of the ship is above the water – so they can roll over quickly in an accident.

Ferry companies did not appreciate the report. They say that ferries are very safe. Indeed, accidents are very rare.

Fortunately, people can get to England without using a ferry. There are planes, and now there's a Tunnel too.
