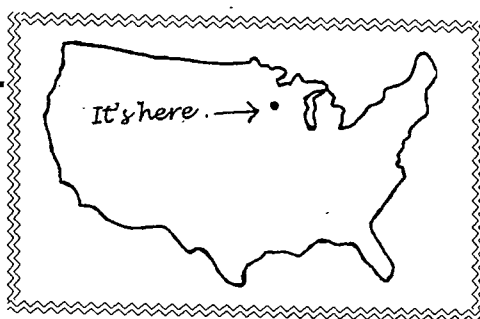


# Vous avez reçu cette lettre des Etats-Unis.

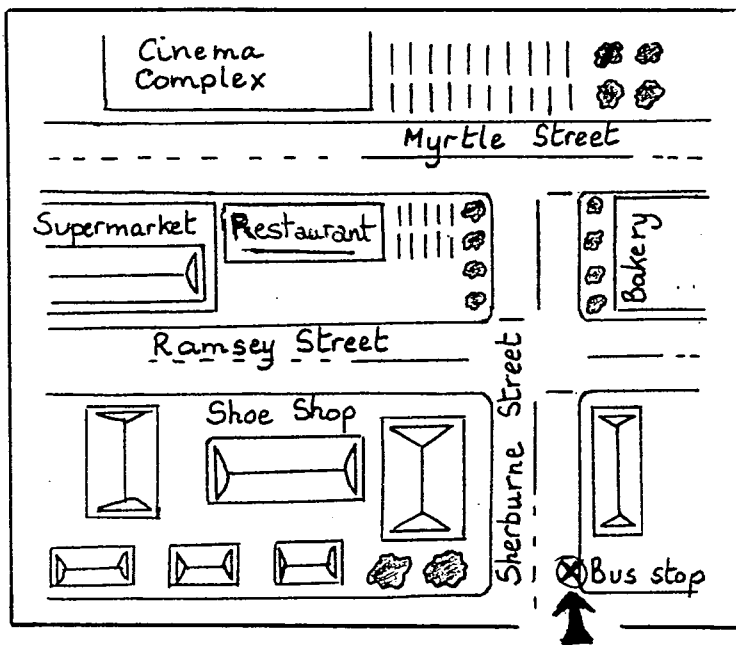
