

CHARLES KINCAID

In September 1946, Charles Kincaid opened a small shop in Fort Worth, Texas. In 1964 he started cooking burgers. He cooked the burgers on a small grill in the back room and served them on a small table in his shop. Today, Charles Kincaid makes thousands of burgers each week in his new big hamburger restaurant. But the recipe for the burgers is still the same and Charles Kincaid's hamburgers are considered as the best hamburgers in the United States.

Charles Kincaid is a good representative of the burger phenomenon in America: / Americans ordered 5 billion burgers in 1998. / The burger represents more than 43 percent of all fast-food sales. (sales = ventes) / The burger is more than 100 years old but there are always new hamburger recipes and new hamburger restaurants. / From a \$1 basic burger to a \$10 four-star burger, the burger is the American classic. / It has surpassed blue jeans as the symbol of America abroad. (abroad = à l'étranger)
