WRONG: Edmund Hillary's fragile appearance belied his promising potential. (l. 3)

At school, he was in a gym group for those lacking co-ordination (and admitted to feeling "a deep sense of inferiority"). (l. 4-5)

He went to a school near his home.

WRONG: But the 40-mile journey to school in Auckland each day... (l. 6)

The expedition to Everest was difficult.

RIGHT: After a gruelling climb up the southern face, battling the effects of high altitude and bad weather... (l. 12-13)

After the expedition to Everest, Edmund Hillary stopped climbing.

WRONG: During the next two decades, he (led expeditions to the South Pole, searched for the fabled Yeti, and) completed six Himalayan ascents. (l. 17-18)

The conquest of Everest was Hillary's greatest satisfaction.

WRONG: Although he will always be remembered for reaching Everest, his greatest satisfaction came with the Nepalese people he befriended. (l. 22-23)

He said : "My most worthwhile things have been the building of schools and clinics. That has given me more satisfaction than a footprint on a mountain". (l. 23 à 25)
